 - OCTOBER (CLASS TEST WITH TRACKING REPORT)
 - DECEMBER (CLASS TEST WITH TRACKING REPORT)
 - MARCH (CLASS TEST WITH TRACKING REPORT)
 - MAY (SUMMER EXAM WITH ANNUAL REPORT)
- At each stage, you will receive your child's performance based on a stanine or level between 1-9 for all subjects – via SIMs App
- You will also receive information on attendance and behaviour
- Parents / Subject Teacher Meeting will be in April

You have received your child's:


- National CAT Stanine

- At the end of Year 8, performance in Key Subjects in Summer Examinations will be taken into account along with CAT Stanine on entry to re-stream classes for Year 9.

- Let us know if there are reasons why it cannot be done












Attendance






