
Log in using your **C2K username** and **password**.



Locating Google Classroom




On MySchool, click on Google Classroom on the 'Launch' panel



Pick your role (Year 8 only)





When using Google Classroom for the first time you will be asked to pick your role – click 'I'm a student'

Joining a class (part 1)



Click on the + icon at the top right and choose **Join Class**.



Joining a class (part 2)




Enter the 'class code' here as advised by your teacher. Each class

The Corridor






All the classes you have joined appear in the 'corridor' on Google Classroom. Each class will have a name to make it clear for you to know what subject it is.

The Stream (part 1)





When you first enter a class you will automatically be on the **Stream** tab.

The Stream is a noticeboard, which gives an overview of the latest posts that have been made in this class. When your teacher posts something new, it will appear here.

The Stream (part 2)






When you click on a post on the Stream, you will then be able to **view** the information within the post. Information will vary depending on the type of post your teacher has made. In the example above this is an 'Assignment' post. This means the teacher wants you to submit work to them using Google Classroom.

Classwork (part 1)






Click on the

Classwork (part 2)






Clicking on any material within the Classwork tab should reveal instructions — if your teacher has provided these. This is an example of an assignment.

Resources to help with an assignment may be attached by your teacher. Click to open.


Click 'View assignment' to open the set assignment

Opening a resource






Once you have opened a resource you can open it in Google Docs/Google Slides, or you can download it.

Uploading an assignment (part 1)






Reopen the assignment on Google Classroom and click on 'Add or create'


Uploading an assignment (part 2)





Marking work as 'done'






The 'Mark as Done' button can be used to make your teacher aware that you have completed a set assignment or quiz.
